

# K-Rec Konnect - Family Information Sheet

Policies are subject to change based on state guidelines and protocols.

Notification Policy: Parents/Guardians will be informed of any program changes via **email and text** blast. Please ensure you are receiving our current e-mail notifications.

### **Water Bottle Policy**

- Children MUST bring their own water bottle daily. If a child arrives without one, they will need to leave with their family to retrieve it before returning.
- A **touch-free water refill station** is available in the building. We will not provide cups, to maintain sanitization standards.

## **Drop-Off Procedure**

O DO NOT drop off children unattended. Counselors are not available before the scheduled drop-off time due to morning staff meetings.

Parents/Guardians must walk their child to the designated check-in area with their group counselor. This applies to ALL ages, including 7th & 8th graders.

## **Pick-Up Procedure**

Parents/Guardians must walk to the designated area and sign out their child with their counselor.

If someone other than a parent/guardian is picking up your child, a written note must be provided to the Lead Counselor at drop-off. Phone calls and emails will NOT be accepted due to participant volume and staff availability, as we may not receive the e-mail on time as we are not always at our desks.

#### **Daily Essentials**

- √ Water Bottle Must be brought every day.
- √ Sneakers Required for activities.
- ✓ No Food Unless medically necessary or staying for full day.
- ✓ Full Day Participants Bring a lunch and a snack. Lunches will be dropped off at the designated area in the lower hall.
- ✓ No Cell Phones or Electronics To avoid distractions, loss, or damage, these items are NOT permitted.

#### **Weather Policies**

Heat Advisory: In the event of a Severe Heat Advisory, the program may need to be canceled for the day.

Rainy Days: We'll provide rainy-day options inside though activities will be limited due to space.
